- Employing an additional teacher to support students learning of reading and literacy across the curriculum. - **\$17,733.96**
- Employing additional Speech Therapy time to assess students with speech requirements and provide direction to Teacher Aides with speech programs on a more regular basis. - **\$1,866.04**
- Providing TRS (Teacher Relief Scheme) and Professional Development to develop teacher and teacher aide knowledge of the teaching of reading in order to increase staff capacity in reading and comprehension strategies. - **\$1000.00**
- Updating reading resources to support students with their reading. - **\$1,500.00**
